

# CENTRE FOR INTERCULTURAL STUDIES AND DIALOGUE (CISD)

The Centre emphasizes intercultural studies and dialogue within a multicultural setting of Manipal and India. Focused on cultural interactions and negotiations, it conducts research and engages with cultural training and experience programs for international and national visitors to Manipal. The Centre organizes summer and winter school every year for international participants with an aim to introduce them to Indian ways of thinking and living at a microcosmic level. 
