2. PhD Program

The broad objectives of the PhD programme are to contribute to the creation of new knowledge and enable the researcher to develop the competency of conducting research individually or in a group later. MAHE Manipal offers Doctoral (PhD) studies in a wide range of areas covering the streams listed in the table above.

MAHE Manipal encourages research in interdisciplinary areas through a system of joint supervision and interdepartmental group activities. 2000+ students have completed their Doctoral studies from MAHE Manipal, in the last 5 years and have 20,000+ national & international publications to its credit

2.1 Categories of PhD Admissions

Applicants can aspire to the following categories, in the current admissions cycle.

- Full-Time (with Dr. TMA Pai Scholarships) **(Category 2)**
- Full-Time PhD (Self – Financed) **(Category 3)**
- Part-Time (For working professionals without scholarship) **(Category 6)**

The details of various PhD categories available at MAHE and application processes are given below.

2.1.1 Category 1: Full-Time PhD (without Scholarship) with Valid National Fellowships

- Duration
 - Minimum 3.5 years from date of admission, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
 - Candidates under AICTE-QIP program & Post Graduates with UGC / CSIR – NET – JRF / ICMR – JRF / DBT – JRF / JEST / INSPIRE / NDF, **and** having a valid fellowship at the time of admission are eligible to apply for Full-Time PhD program under this category.
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Four times a year (January, April, July and October)
 - Selection to the PhD program under this category would be done by a panel of experts through

presentation and an interview

- Course Fee
 - Selected candidates are exempted from paying the course fee for minimum course duration
- Stipend & Other Support
 - Contingency grant of Rs. 1,50,000 per year, for 3 years will be given for research work of the PhD student to cover equipment, consumables and publication costs.
 - This amount cannot be used for the manpower and travel.
 - Financial assistance to a maximum of Rs. 50,000 during the PhD program will be provided for presenting paper at national / international conference(s).
 - This amount can be utilized within 3.5 years of admission or before thesis submission, whichever is earlier
 - Above facilities can be availed with prior approval from MAHE, Manipal

 - Completed application and supporting documents to be submitted to Centre for Doctoral Studies (CDS), MAHE as per the instructions given in the application.

2.1.2 Category 2: Full-Time PhD with Dr. TMA Pai Scholarships

- Duration
 - Minimum 3.5 years from date of admission, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
 - Candidates who fulfil the [Eligibility Criteria](#) are eligible to apply for Full-Time PhD program (with scholarships) under this category.
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Twice a year (July and January)
 - Candidates must appear for All India Online Remote Proctored Computer Based PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) conducted by MAHE Manipal
 - Candidates who qualified UGC-NET exam or GATE /GPAT Exam with Cutoff marks applicable for the general category for the academic year 2024, 2025, 2026 are exempted from Ph.D. Manipal Entrance Test.
 - Candidates who qualified in JGEEBILS (Joint Graduate Entrance Examination for Biology and Interdisciplinary Life Sciences) with Cutoff marks applicable for the general category for the academic year 2025 are exempted from Ph.D. Manipal Entrance Test
 - All the candidates who qualify PhD MET will be shortlisted for an institute / department level interview. Similarly, candidates who are exempted from PhD MET will be subjected to an institute / department level interview.
 - Dr. TMA Pai PhD Scholarship programme Candidates shortlisted through the interview process will be eligible for grant-in-aid instituted by MAHE, Manipal

2.1.3 Category 3: Full-Time PhD (Self – Financed)

- Duration
 - Minimum 3.5 years from date of admission, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
 - Candidates who fulfil the [Eligibility Criteria](#) are eligible to apply for Full-Time PhD program in Self-Financed mode under this category
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Twice a year (July and January)
 - Candidates must appear for All India Online Remote Proctored Computer Based PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) conducted by MAHE Manipal
 - Candidates who qualified UGC-NET assistant professorship exam or GATE /GPAT Exam with Cutoff marks applicable for the general category for the academic year 2024, 2025, 2026 are exempted from Ph.D. Manipal Entrance Test
 - Candidates who qualified in JGEEBILS (Joint Graduate Entrance Examination for Biology and Interdisciplinary Life Sciences) with Cutoff marks applicable for the general category for the academic year 2025 are exempted from Ph.D. Manipal Entrance Test
 - Shortlisted candidates who qualify through PhD MET, will be subjected to an institute / department level interview

2.1.4 Category 4: Full-Time PhD for Project Fellows

- Duration
 - 6 years maximum
- Eligibility
 - Project Fellows working under funded projects in MAHE Institutions / Departments and meeting the eligibility criteria specified in MAHE PhD guidelines, can apply for full-time PhD program under this category.
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Four times a year (January, April, July and October)
 - Project Fellows must appear for Institute / Department level test
 - Candidates who qualified UGC-NET assistant professorship exam or GATE /GPAT Exam with Cutoff marks applicable for the general category for the academic year 2024, 2025, 2026 are

exempted from Ph.D. Manipal Entrance Test

- Shortlisted candidates will be called for Institute / Department level interview

2.1.5 **Category 5: Full-Time PhD at Collaborating Research Centres**

- Duration
 - Minimum 3.5 years from date of admission for full-time candidates, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
 - Candidates who work in Research Centres collaborating with MAHE Manipal, are eligible to apply for the full-time or part-time PhD program under this category.

2.1.6 **Category 6: Part-Time PhD for working professionals**

- Duration
 - Minimum 4.5 years (4 years 6 months) from date of admission, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
 - Candidates fulfilling the [Eligibility Criteria](#) are eligible to apply for Part-Time PhD program in Self-Financed mode under this category
 - Candidates **MUST** have at least 2 years of work experience as permanent full-time employee at the time of document submission as per the timeline notified
 - Candidates who are employed on Ad hoc / part-time / temporary / contract / probation / visiting / guest faculty / freelancer or self-employed in the current organization are not eligible.
 - At least one co-guide from the current organization / from the same vicinity where the candidate is working is mandatory.
 - Co-guide must meet the criteria specified for PhD Co-Guide as per Manipal Academy of Higher Education. It is the responsibility of the candidate and Guide to ensure that Co-Guide meets the eligibility criteria and necessary approval is obtained at the time of document submission as per the timeline notified.
 - Co-Guide must NOT be from any one of the constituent Institutions of Manipal Academy of Higher Education. However, additional Co-guide may be from any one of the constituent Institution of MAHE.
 - Indian Nationals working abroad and Foreign Nationals working abroad, or India are not eligible to apply under this category
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Twice a year (July and January)
 - Candidates must appear for All India Online Remote Proctored Computer Based PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) conducted by MAHE Manipal

2.1.7 **Category 7: International candidates**

- Duration
Minimum 3.5 years from date of admission, Maximum 6 years
- Eligibility
Candidates fulfilling the [Eligibility Criteria](#) are eligible to apply for Full-Time PhD program under this category.
- Admission Process
 - Admission Schedule: Four times a year (January, April, July and October)
 - Selection to the PhD program under this category would be done by a panel of experts through presentation and an interview
 - *Such candidates are exempted from All India Online Remote Proctored Computer Based PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) conducted by MAHE Manipal*
 - Candidates shortlisted through the interview process will be eligible for grant-in-aid instituted by MAHE Manipal which is at par with Dr. TMA Pai PhD Scholarships

 - Completed application and supporting documents to be submitted to Centre for Doctoral Studies (CDS), MAHE as per the instructions given in the application.

 - The above facilities can be availed with prior approval from MAHE Manipal
 - Candidates will **NOT** accept additional salary / stipend, etc., from any other source during the tenure of the fellowship

2.2 **Duration of PhD program**

- The minimum duration for full-time PhD program is 3.5 years i.e., (3 years 6 months) from the date of admission for category 1, 2, 3, 5 and 7
 - Date of joining at the institution, is considered as the date of registration for PhD
 - The duration of the program will be calculated from the date of joining, till the award of degree
 - Extension beyond the minimum period will be based only on the recommendation of the Doctoral Advisory Committee (DAC). This requires approval of Centre for Doctoral Studies (CDS) MAHE Manipal
- The maximum duration shall **NOT** exceed six (06) years.

3. Eligibility Criteria

A candidate seeking admission to the PhD program **MUST** fulfill the following eligibility criteria

3.1 Indian Qualifications

A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme from an institution / university recognized by UGC / respective regulatory body after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme OR A 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme from an institution / university recognized by UGC / respective regulatory body after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme	60% marks in aggregate or its equivalent in master degree
4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme from an institution / university recognized by UGC / respective regulatory body	75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade
MBBS/BDS/PharmD degree from an institution / university recognized by UGC / respective regulatory body	60% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade

3.2 International Qualifications

In case of International qualification (meeting the above criteria mentioned under Indian Qualifications), it should be from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

Note:

Admissions guidelines are updated for each session. Qualifications or types of Experience certificates accepted in previous admission cycles should not be used as a reference for the current cycle. Candidates MUST meet the eligibility criteria specified for the current admission cycle.

All the candidates seeking admission MUST complete the joining formalities within the stipulated time. No extension will be provided for submission of original documents for verification under any circumstances.

- Question Paper will have MCQs on Research Aptitude
 - Max Marks: **240**
 - Total Questions: **60**
 - Test Pattern
 - ✓ Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs): For all 3 streams

Note:

1. The mode of Examination will be **Online Remote Proctored Computer Based Test** and will be conducted through **Secure Examination Browser** with **Primary and Secondary cameras** on **windows compatible Desktop or Laptop ONLY**
2. It is **MANDATORY** for the candidate to position the primary and secondary cameras **STRICTLY** as per the guidelines of Online Remote Proctored Computer base test and live stream both Primary and Secondary camera feed throughout the examination. Failure follow these instructions will automatically lead to “disqualification”.
3. It is the responsibility of the applicant to make suitable arrangements such as compatible laptop/desktop, configuration requirements for the examination.
4. As the examination is online proctored, a good internet connection is required. MAHE will not be held responsible for disruption, if any, in the examination due to configurational or internet related issues.
5. 4.3 PhD Manipal Entrance Test (MET) Syllabus

The test intends to assess basic research aptitude of the candidate based on reasoning ability, comprehension and general awareness.

An assessment of the basic research aptitude will be carried out in the following content:

- **Research Aptitude (15)**
Research and its types, methods of research, research process, styles of referencing, qualitative and quantitative methods of research, sampling
- **Numerical and Logical Reasoning (15)**
Number series, codes and relationships, fraction, time and distance, rate proportion, profit and loss etc, Deductive and inductive reasoning, mood and figure, analogies.
- **Data Interpretation (15)**
Classification of data, sources of data, graphical interpretation, data interpretation, Data governance.
- **English (15)**
Passage followed by questions, antonyms and synonyms.

This can be recommended as part of preparations for the Entrance examination. This MOOC is about demystifying research and research methods. It will outline the fundamentals of doing research, aimed primarily, but not exclusively, at the postgraduate level.
