- To make you comfortable adjusting to the medical career, we have a Mentors' Cell with faculty to guide you at each stage. Student and parents will meet with the respective Mentors on the Orientation day.
- The Foundation Course will be full of interesting activities to help you settle down and includes a first-aid training program, ethics and professionalism etc.
- The Bank requirements, mobile network connection details are also appended. Please bring the necessary documents.
- The student information general and other interests are to be filled in the student profile card along with hobby/extracurricular interest form (Annexure 1).
- Students need to get vaccinated to prevent them from getting infected during their medical course. Information regarding the same is hereby attached (Page 6 and 7). Kindly ensure it is done or you may also get it done after your arrival in Manipal. Students, who have already got vaccinated, please carry with you a medical certificate of the same.
- Ragging is a criminal offence as per the Karnataka Educational Act 1983 and Honorable Supreme Court of India. Please visit the following website: http://manipal.edu/mu/admission/anti-ragging-.html
 - There is a declaration form attached concerned with ragging which needs your parent/guardian's signature. Please do fill that appropriately and submit it when you arrive here (Annexure 1).
- The nearest airport is in Mangalore situated 70 km away from Manipal. You can reach here via a prepaid taxi. A list of hotels in Manipal and a map of Manipal is attached for your reference. The nearest railway stations are in Udupi (5 km away) and in Mangalore.
- Please carry a sufficient number of your recent passport size photographs (atleast 10).

- 2. Three recent passport sized colour photographs

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Vaccination information

MANDATORY VACCINE:

· Hepatitis B

3 doses - 0, 1 and 6 months intramuscular Approximate cost: Rs. 80 per dose

DESIRABLE VACCINES:

· Chicken pox vaccine

All adults who have never had chickenpox or have never received this vaccination should be vaccinated against it. Two doses of the vaccine (subcutaneous) should be given at least four weeks apart.

Approximate cost: Rs 1700/-

MMR vaccine

Single dose, if not vaccinated in the last 5 years

Approximate cost: Rs 160/-

OPTIONAL VACCINES:

· Typhoid vaccine

Single dose (IM) and booster dose every 3 years

Approximate cost: Rs 290/-

Hepatitis A vaccine

2 doses - 0, 6 months

Approximate cost: Rs 2100/-



HEALTH INSTRUCTIONS

FOOD / WATER BORNE DISEASES



Typhoid, Hepatitis A & Gastroenteritis are food and water borne communicable diseases. Students are advised to take appropriate preventive measures. Use safe drinking water, dine at restaurants of good reputation with good hygienic standards.

Optional Vaccination

Typhoid Vaccine

Single dose (Intramuscular)

3 years immunity following vaccination

Cost: ₹290/- (approx.)

Hepatitis A Vaccine

2 doses

0, 6 months

Cost: ₹1,050/- per dose (approx.)

HEPATITIS B



Hepatitis B Infection is an occupational hazard for health science students. To protect oneself, the following vaccination is recommended.

Hepatitis 'B' Vaccine

3 doses

0, 1, 6 months (Intra muscular)

Cost: ₹80/- per dose (approx.)

CHICKENPOX / MEASLES



Chickenpox & Measles outbreak in the campus is a source of concern. It is therefore strongly recommended that students who have not had prior Chickenpox / Measles infection or not been vaccinated for the same take the following vaccinations.

Chickenpox Vaccine

(If there is no history of a childhood episode or not vaccinated earlier)

2 doses

0, 6 Weeks (Subcutaneous)

Cost: ₹1,700/- per dose (approx.)

Measles-Mumps-Rubella (MMR) Vaccine

(If not vaccinated in the last 5 years)

Single dose

Cost: ₹160/- (approx.)

NO SMOKING It is against the law to smoke in the campus

MALARIA / DENGUE



Prevention is better than cure

It is recommended that the students take the following precautions

- 1. Use mosquito nets while sleeping.
- 2. Use mosquito repellents when outdoors at dawn and dusk.
- 3. Avoid littering and keeping open containers where water could stagnate.

What constitutes Ragging?

"Ragging is any disorderly conduct whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling rudely any student, indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities which cause or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely effect the psyche of a fresher or a junior student.".... The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India

Ragging is a criminal offence.

Warning

No leniency will be shown to the offenders involved in ragging. All students are requested to note and co-operate in keeping the university and its constituent colleges free of ragging. If found to be an offender, the following actions will be resorted to:

- Suspension / Rustication / Expulsion from the college
- Fine up to ₹2.5 lakhs

Penalty for Ragging

No person who is a student of an educational institution shall commit ragging. Supreme Court of India has ordered that "if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of the authority, the concerned student shall be given liberty to explain and if his/her explanation is not found satisfactory, the authority would expel him/her from the institution".


OBJECTIVE

To provide optimum healthcare to all the students of Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE)

INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL MAHE STUDENTS

Utilization of Healthcare Services at Kasturba Hospital, Manipal

- 1. The student health clinic will function on all days (except Sundays, MAHE holidays). Working hours 8.00 am 1.00 pm and 2.00 pm 5.00 pm
- 2. Between 1.00 pm 2.00 pm and 5.00 pm 6.30 pm registrations will be done at Ground floor, New OPD building. Consultations will be done at Medicine OPD (2nd floor).
- 3. Students can contact the Patient Relation Executive (PRE) posted at student health clinic previous day by phone (0820-2922057) or in person for availing appointment with the consultant and / or to register the file for next day. This will save time and prevent absenteeism from regular classes.
- 4. During working hours students are directed to register at student health clinic and attend the respective outpatient department thereafter (Refer Annexure-I).
- 5. In case of accident/injury students should report to Trauma & Emergency centre directly. (Refer Annexure-II)
- 6. Between 6.30 pm and 8.00 am any student requiring medical attention should visit casualty and will be managed as inpatient.
- 7. Students should produce their ID Card / Combo Card while visiting the hospital / at the time of admission at hospital
- 8. Impersonation / misuse of combo cards is a criminal offense and will be dealt with accordingly.
- 9. Only one hospital file should be made per student. This will facilitate proper documentation and comprehensive care.
- 10. Admitted students are not permitted to go out of the ward until discharge.
- 11. Students must settle the bills in time before discharge.
- 12. Medical certificates cannot be demanded from the Doctors.
- 13. Request hospital ambulance for genuine cases only. Caretaker has to accompany the students in the ambulance.
- 14. Ambulance will be provided free of cost within the MAHE campus. Charges will apply for the services of ambulance outside the MAHE campus.



Report to T&E Block registration cum admission counter with Combo Card / ID Card 8.00 am - 6.30 pm: Treatment on OP basis 6.30 pm - 8.00 am: Treatment on IP basis i.e. the student will be admitted for the well-being of the patient. The blood sample is collected by the Nurse Incharge and sent through PTS/HSK to the respective lab for testing Radiological investigations will be done in Trauma X-Ray

----- DO'S & DON'TS -----

In the wake of certain unsavory incidents over the last few months, the Management of Manipal Academy of Higher Education and Udupi Police have chalked out plans to put an end these incidents for the security and safety of the students in the MAHE. This move is to ensure that students enjoy their stay on the campus or off it, so that after they graduate and leave the portals they will take back rich memories of their stay in Manipal. The MAHE is prepared to do everything for the holistic development of every student and in turn the student is expected to live up to all expectations, not only of the MAHE but also the dreams of their loved ones far away.

For this purpose, the MAHE and Udupi Police have come up with a few do's and don'ts for students staying in hostels and outside. They are:

- ▶ Rules and regulations are already in place both for hostels (MAHE) and for those staying outside (Police). They will have to be strictly adhered to at all times.
- ▶ MAHE will take strict action against any student who indulges in substance abuse and verbal abuses/quarrel/misbehavior with Police/Security Personnel and causing obstruction for duties. Such students will be booked under section 353 IPC and MAHE rules and regulations.
- ▶ Random check of student premises will be carried out and the students will even be subjected to drug and alcohol tests if a situation so
- ▶ Students with two wheelers or four wheelers are to have complete documents in possession always. If any vehicle is found without relevant papers, the vehicle will be seized and handed over to the Manipal Police authorities.
- Foreign students are also expected to abide by the law of the land. They risk deportation if found to be involved in illegal activities. Students are also requested to cooperate and bring unlawful acts immediately to the notice of concerned authorities.
- ▶ Police will ensure all restaurants will wind up business at 11.30 pm.
- No student will be allowed to be on road after 12.30 am for any reason. They will be taken to the police station if they are found roaming on the streets after that time.
- ▶ Karnataka Police Act (Section 92- maintenance of public order) will be enforced as and when warranted
- ▶ COTPA 2003 act will be enforced by Police if any student is found smoking inside the campus premises and within 100 meters of radius from the outer boundary of educational institutions.
- Motor Vehicles Act will be enforced if any student is found involved in drag race in traffic violations and sound pollution ...etc. in and around the MAHE campus.
- ▶ Four task forces of six police officials each (3 men and 3 women) will be in place to monitor the student activities in and around the apartments. And COO campus safety and 2 Senior Security Officers of MAHE will be on special night duty in the MAHE campus.

All these instructions will come into effect forthwith.

Hospital Rules / Guidelines for Students

Admitted in Kasturba Hospital, Manipal

- 1. Students must possess the college id card at the time of admission.
- 2. Impersonation / misuse of college id card is a criminal offense and will be dealt with accordingly.
- 3. Hospital Admission will be informed by the Student Clinic to the HOI of respective institutions.
- 4. When the condition is more than mild / when surgery is indicated, parents will be informed.
- 5. Only one person will be allowed as a bystander at night (same gender).
- 6. Visitors must adhere to the hospital's Visiting Timings. Students and visitors are requested to co-operate in maintaining the silence and discipline of the hospital.
- 7. Students are not permitted to go out of the ward until discharge.
- 8. Students must settle the bills in time before discharge.
- 9. Students coming to emergency for simple reasons, especially after 8.00 pm, will be admitted till next day morning.
- 10. Medical certificates cannot be demanded from the Doctors.
- 11. Request hospital ambulance for genuine cases only. Caretaker has to accompany the students in the ambulance.
- 12. Ambulance will be provided free of cost within the MAHE campus. Charges will apply for the services of ambulance outside the MAHE campus.



POLICY ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Objective:

To prevent substance abuse and to create a secure, conducive atmosphere for learning among the students in the campus.

The University adheres to the following guidelines concerning the possession, use and/or distribution of substances of abuse: Cannabis, Heroin, Benzodiazepines, barbiturates, Flunitrazepam, Cocaine, Ketamine, Psilocybin, Lysergic acid diethylamide, Amphetamine, Methamphetamines, MDMA, Phencyclidine, GHB, Methaqualone, Inhalants and any other drugs and substances mentioned in The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Act 1985.

- 1. The possession, use and/or distribution of substances of abuse are prohibited on premises owned or controlled by the University.
- 2. University squads will carry out random checks on students/residential premises for substances of abuse.
- 3. Possession, use and/or distribution of substances of abuse will attract appropriate disciplinary action which may include expulsion.

Offenders will also come under the purview of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act 1985 (NDPS Act) and will be liable for penal action.

Disciplinary procedures:


A student violating the MAHE policy on substance abuse will face:

- a) Immediate suspension from the college, pending enquiry.
- b) Parent/legal guardian will be informed immediately who will be expected to meet the Head of Institution (HOI) at the earliest.
- c) The Institutional Disciplinary Committee will conduct an enquiry and submit the report to HOI who will initiate further action in consultation with the Director Student Affairs, Manipal Academy of Higher Education.

Policy matters on Alcohol & Tobacco

- The University campus is declared as "Alcohol/Tobacco free campus"
- If a student is found possessing / consuming Tobacco/Alcohol in the premises owned or controlled by the University, the Institutional Disciplinary Committee will take appropriate action.
