

The program was attended by final year undergraduate students, interns and faculty from MCODS, Mangalore and MCODS, Manipal and also alumni of MCODS, Mangalore.








Army Calling







This webinar covered newer topics in research domain of dentistry such as orofacial pain, sleep apnea and periodontal regeneration.


