


Pandemic & MCODS Mangalore






Activities Covid Era





EXPERIENCE OF A LIFETIME!! - Dr Raviraj

Its 4 am in the morning, and I am still at work, wearing PPE and screening patients in a designated covid hospital, screaming at the top of my lungs, at an overwhelming number of clueless, tired, hungry migrant workers who have walked miles to their native place and reached their Govt district hospital. I feel for them, but damn! I am tired too!! Its been eight hour since my shift began. I feel frustrated and hopeless. But I can't tell them my shift is done. I can't tell them that there aren't enough doctors to screen them and so they have to wait for hours, and I definitely cant tell them I am a dentist by profession, who doubts his capabilities to deal with this pandemic. I have been trained recently through a few workshops to screen and handle suspected COVID positive patients. However, facing medical complications far beyond the realms of my specialty, I can't help but wonder.... Am I ready to treat these patients? I am Dr Raviraj, a dental specialist working in Govt district hospital, Gumla; a district known for migration of laborers. When I was assigned these special covid duties, my mortal fears were at its peak and I was worried for me and my family whose responsibility I carry. I started out annoyed and rebellious. But when I saw those workers who were facing innumerable challenges for survival, who suffer beyond words can describe; seeing their helplessness, their poverty, the fear in their eyes, I couldn't help but feel a sense of responsibility. IF NOT ME THEN WHO???? This moral obligation has given me the courage to venture out of the boundaries of dentistry. It has made me realize the true meaning of a health care professional and service to humanity. In a pandemic like this roles have changed. Professors and scholars and many more are no longer confined to their defined roles. We as a society need to accept this and rise to face this challenge. I am not just a dentist, I am a frontline corona warrior. Being a dentist I am proud to have tried my best to save lives and fight this pandemic for my people, my country, and this feeling is something that I will cherish for all my life.
