Guidelines for Submission of Abstract

Health professionals interested in presenting at the conclave are requested to submit an abstract to the conclave office using the abstract submission link available in the conclave web site at

<https://conference.manipal.edu/ic2022/Default.aspx>

Please read the following instructions before submitting the abstract:

1. Only original research studies/systematic reviews will be accepted.
2. The word limit for the abstract is 500.
3. The last date to submit the abstract is November 30, 2021.
4. Abstract title should be brief (maximum 20 words).
5. Abstract should include:
 - i. Introduction
 - ii. Objectives
 - iii. Methods and materials, including ethical considerations
 - iv. Results / Expected Outcomes
 - v. Conclusion
6. Indicate the preferred method of online presentation: poster/oral
7. Poster should be pre-recorded (3-5 minutes) and to be sent to scientific committee. Paper presentation is through online mode only.
8. Indicate theme category.
9. Submission of declaration is mandatory for the approval of the abstract (format is available in the website).
10. A confirmation mail and a tracking number will be sent for future correspondence.
11. Abstract will be checked for similarity index. If the content is found to be plagiarized, it will be sent back to presenting author for modification.
12. The scientific committee will scrutinize all the submitted abstracts.
13. Approved abstract will be notified on or before December 31, 2021.
14. Only presenting author will receive certificate for oral presentation. Two authors will receive certificate for poster presentation and both should register for the conclave.
