
Orientation Day





Digital Namma Angadi 2021: For seventeen years, Namma Angadi has helped to bridge the gap between local coastal Karnataka crafts and customers from across the world. Each year, the students of MIC gear up to present a remarkable weekend fiesta attracting several glocal customers on campus. Keeping in mind the spirit of Namma Angadi and its importance as a community event, an offline Namma Angadi was initially planned. However, MIC, Namma Bhoomi, and Manipal did not foresee the sudden second wave of COVID-19 in Manipal. The originally planned, physical exhibition cum sale was canceled. Instead, the team after quick consultations with the Director and Namma Bhoomi authorities decided to move Namma Angadi 2021 online under the fruitful mentoring of the faculty co-ordinator **Ms Sowparnika Pawan Kumar Attavar.**

In lieu MIC decided to use Instagram, Facebook, and WhatsApp as the platforms for selling Namma Angadi products. To achieve this, an easy-to-navigate digital product catalog was created which was shared with the customers and promoted on social media. In addition, the student team also created a real-time inventory management system to track the availability of stocks.

The first-ever digital Namma Angadi collected a whopping

Rs 4,48,000 over three days, despite limited products and digital novelty. It catered to more than 200 customers, making it a grand success. The event was not without its crises, but the teams worked hand-in-hand to pull the event out of all issues.




3. Faculty & Staff Updates

MIC welcomed two new faculty members into its club in year 2020:

Prof B P Sanjay, & Dr Chandana Kumar Vemana.





Dr B P Sanjay had his academic training in communication and journalism in Bangalore and obtained a PhD from Simon Fraser University, Canada. He taught at Madras University and MS University, Tirunelveli before he moved to University of Hyderabad as a Professor in 1995. He was involved in studying the historic SITE experiment and his professional expertise and interests are in the areas of political economy of information and communication technologies, development communication, and international communication. Ever since, he has been associated with various national and international bodies that chalk out policies on media education and research. Notably, on the administrative front, he was the Director of the Indian Institute of Mass Communication (IIMC), Delhi, and the Pro Vice-chancellor of the university. He also served as the first Vice-Chancellor of Central University of Tamil Nadu. Thiruvarur, between 2009 and 2014. Meanwhile, he was the Director of the College of Integrated Studies at the university, and served as the Pro Vice-Chancellor of the university between June 2016-July 2018.

Most prominently, Dr Sanjay is part of the Editorial Advisory Board of Journalism and is a Mass Communication Educator.

Recently, Professor B P Sanjay presented his quintessential views on the topics "Time Management for a Teacher" and "Issues in the competitive world for Teachers" in an Induction Training Program for faculty members of HEIs conducted by the Central University of Rajasthan, on 24th and 25th January 2021.

Dr Sanjay was also invited as the chairperson for 'plenary session 3' in the 4th National Media Conclave – 2020 which presented the broad theme of "Communication for Social Change" - 21 and 22 Nov 2020. Odisha, India.



Dr Chandana Kumar Vemana had completed a doctoral study at Pondicherry Central University as a UGC Senior Research Fellow awardee in Performing Arts. The creative amalgamation of Art and Media technology was focused intensively in the area of 'Media Projection design for Multimedia Art'. 
Director Duo Ranadeep Bhattacharyya and Judhajit Bagchi are






